How to Respond to the **Invitation of Christian** Discipleship

After the sermon you are invited to come down front where the minister will receive and welcome you, should you feel moved by the Spirit of God to unite with this congregation.

We invite you to unite by:

1) Profession of faith

In Jesus Christ, baptism, and confirmation. If you have never been a member of any church, you may unite by professing Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior.

2) Restored

If you have been a member of Wesley or another United Methodist Church at one time, but have been inactive for at least three years or more, you may unite by renewing your faith in Jesus Christ as your Lord and Savior and restoring membership in the church.

3) Transfer

If you are a member of another United Methodist Church or another denomination, you may request your membership be transferred to Wesley.

4) Affiliate Member

If you are a member of a United Methodist Church in another city, state, or country, but will be residing in the Oklahoma City area, you may unite as an affiliate member. You will maintain membership in your home church, but be under the Pastoral care of Wesley UMC.

All persons are children of God and are welcome here. If anyone has any questions about membership at Wesley or about how to have a relationship with Jesus, please feel free to ask the Minister or staff.
